



## **Privacy Statement JWH initiative**

At the Joke Waller Hunter initiative (JWHi), we value your privacy. In this Privacy Statement, you can read what personal information JWHi collects when you visit our website and/or apply for a grant, how we use that information and what you can do if you have a question or complaint about the way we obtain or use your personal information.

### **1. What personal information do we collect?**

When you visit this website, JWHi may collect:

- Information about how you use the website (e.g. the pages you visit, the type of browser and operating system you use; see 'cookies');

When you apply for a grant, JWHi collects – through the submission of a grants application - information on:

- Your name and address, CV, photograph, nomination form (with names and addresses of a nominator and two referees) and payment details.

### **2. What does JWHi do with your information?**

The JWHi may use your personal information in two ways:

JWHi may use your personal information to:

- Administer its website;
- Enable you to access and use its website services;
- In the event that we need to disclose your personal information to our agents or sub-contractors for these purposes (e.g. to a web developer), the agent or sub-contractor in question will be obligated to use that personal information in accordance with the terms of this Privacy Statement.

When you apply for a grant, JWHi may use your personal information to:

- Assess and process a grant request (which may include contacting referees that you have provided)
- Make grant payments
- Request updates from you so as to monitor the impact of our grants
- With your explicit consent, we may use your information to provide insights about grantees on our website; in (annual) reports and/or other possible venues, such as conferences.

JWHi will not disclose your personal information to other parties, except in the unlikely event that we are legally obliged to do so.

### **3. Storing and deleting your personal information**

We store your personal information in the following ways and no longer than necessary:

- Information about how you use the website: we collect this in an anonymous way (see 'cookies')
- Information you provide when applying for a grant: we store this information on our secure server. We will delete your personal information after we no longer need it for the organization of the fund.
- On the website JWHi is publishing an alumni section which contains a photograph, name of the grantee and nominator and sometimes contact possibilities, and a description of the work and achievements of the grantee.

### **4. Cookies**

The JWHi website, like most websites, uses small text files called cookies. A cookie is a tiny element of data that our website can send to your browser, and may then be stored on your computer or mobile device. If you wish to delete, restrict or block cookies, you can set your internet browser to do so.

## **5. Third-party services**

In general, any third-party services used by us (e.g. video hosting websites) will only collect, use and disclose your information to the extent necessary to allow them to perform the services they provide to us. Once you leave our website or are redirected to a third-party website or application, you are no longer governed by this Privacy Statement.

## **6. How do we get your consent?**

If you accept cookies on our websites, you give your consent to our collecting your personal information and using it for that specific reason only.

If you apply for a grant, you give us consent to our collecting your personal information requested in the nomination form, and using it for that specific reason only.

For any other purpose, JWHi will ask your explicit consent to store, display or any other form of use of your personal information.

## **7. Your rights**

You have the following rights regarding our processing of your personal information:

- the right to access, rectify and erase the personal information JWHi has collected about you;
- the right to restrict or object to processing of your personal information;
- the right to withdraw consent to our processing of your personal information;
- the right to complain to the Dutch privacy authority ([Autoriteit Persoonsgegevens](#)) about the way we process your personal information.
